Q. Who are you, and how did you initially come up with the idea for the TRIbella?

My name is Skip Lei, and I spent most of my career in product creation in the footwear industry, with over 30 years at Nike.

I've always been the type of person to ask, "Well, why does it have to be like that?" or "Why can't things be better?" and over the years, I've come up with

several ideas and secured a few different patents, mostly just for the fun and the challenge of the creative process. I hadn't spent much time thinking about wine or wine solutions until my daughter attended Whitman College in Walla Walla, Washington. While visiting her on numerous occasions, my wife and I also began visiting

wineries and tasting rooms in Walla Walla and the beautiful surrounding area. There are over 200 wineries in the Columbia Valley, and they all share a deep passion for the art of winemaking. The idea for the TRIbella began with all of these winery visits. Q. What is the TRIbella? The TRIbella™ is a wine aerator that immediately brings out the best the
